Fire Rescue Crews respond to two weekend structure fires

Revelstoke, B.C – Revelstoke Fire Rescue Services received calls for two residential structure fires this weekend. The first call came in at 2:11 a.m. on February 8, 2025 in the Hideaway Trailer Park, and the second at 3:20 a.m. on February 9, 2025 on Law Road.

Fire Rescue Services responded to the fire in the Hideaway Trailer Park with:

- two command vehicles
- three fire apparatus
- 12 firefighters

The fire, which caused significant damage leaving the structure uninhabitable, was knocked down by the first responding engine.

The occupant of the home sustained injuries and was hospitalized and Emergency Support Services were notified to help the occupant upon release.

Fire crews responded to the fire on Law Road with:

- two command vehicles
- three fire apparatus
- 11 firefighters

The fire, which caused significant damage leaving the structure uninhabitable, proved to be challenging but was eventually extinguished utilizing exterior and interior attack methods.

Two uninjured persons were displaced by the fire and Emergency Support Services was on scene to provide assistance to the occupants.

There were no injuries to firefighters with either incident and both fires are currently under investigation.

The Fire Department thanks BC Hydro, Fortis, BC Ambulance, and the RCMP for their assistance with both of the weekend incidents.
