Further support is needed for the Food Bank with an influx of registrants since mid-march.

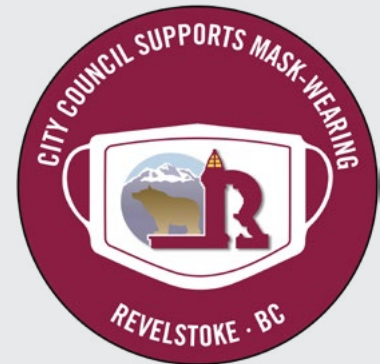
The food bank received approximately 125 new clients in comparison to 52 new registrants in the same time frame, year over year.
