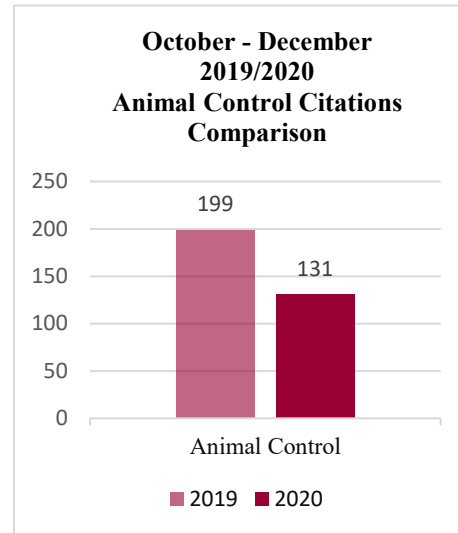
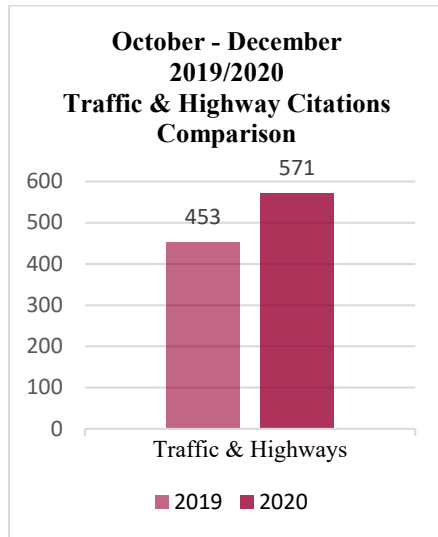

October - December 2020 Quarterly Summary



Animal Control

- 2 dogs were impounded this quarter. Both were returned to their owners.
- 7 aggressive/dangerous dog incidents this period, including a fatal attack on a domestic animal.
- Animal Control citations are higher for 2019 due to an animal control enforcement campaign in October 2019.
- Total of 44 aggressive dog incidents in 2020.

Traffic & Highways:

- 26% increase in Traffic & Highways citations over same quarter last year.
- There were 8 tow requests this quarter.

Additional Notes:

- 20% increase in calls for service compared to same time period last year.
- Calls for November 2020 increased the most, 40% higher than November 2019.
- A large number of warning tickets were issued this quarter, due to Covid-19 and general public education on winter parking regulations.
- Illegal camping complaints rose by over 300%, due to improved reporting ability on See, Click, Fix.
- 26 Covid-19 calls, beginning in the last week of November. There were no Covid-19 calls last quarter.
- \$3400 in fines were issued from November 1 – December 31, plus \$500 Public Nuisance fine issued by the RCMP.
